

Some of our key policies:

- **Reverse Centralisation:**
The Christian Party-CPA is concerned at the ongoing breakdown of local communities and the weakening of local government through centralist policies in Edinburgh, Westminster and Brussels. Too many local matters, such as the pricing of fuel for remote and rural areas, require EU approval. We believe that withdrawal from the European Union will redress the framework within which local government is conducted.
- **Respect for Conscience:**
Respect for conscience has served as a bulwark against tyranny. The Christian Party-CPA believe this is being dangerously discarded by successive Governments and must be urgently restored and defended.
- **Equality and Diversity:**
The Christian Party-CPA will seek to ensure that all local authority equality and diversity policy and training include the Christian perspective on faith, morality, marriage, sexuality, etc.
- **Pro-Life:**
The Christian Party-CPA believes in the sanctify of human life and will oppose attempts to legislate for euthanasia. The Christian Party-CPA believes that the life of the unborn child should be protected to the full extent of the powers available to the Scottish Parliament. The Christian Party-CPA will campaign for full human rights to be given to the unborn child. The Christian Party-CPA will continue to press the Scottish Parliament to seek powers under Scottish law to ban abortions.
- **Appropriate Sex Education for Schoolchildren:**
The Christian Party-CPA will call for sex education classes to be given only to children on a parental opt-in basis. The Christian Party-CPA will fight for the promotion in school of chastity before marriage and faithfulness in marriage, as the only safe sexual practice, as and when sex education is taught. The Christian Party-CPA will oppose sex education in Infant Schools.

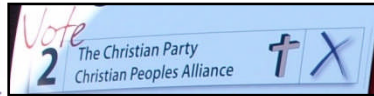

It is now four years on since the Scottish Christian Party contested the Scottish Parliamentary elections, fielding more candidates than almost every other political party in Scotland.

In 2007 Labour had to look on powerlessly as the SNP took five (5) of the list seats in the Central Region, including the very last seat. As a result, the SNP beat Labour by just one (1) seat in the Scottish Parliamentary Election.
