How the voting system works for the 2011 Scottish Parliamentary Election

The system of proportional representation used in the Scottish parliamentary elections is designed to help smaller parties to win seats in the Scottish Parliament.

In the Scottish parliamentary election each voter has two votes. A vote is cast by putting an X beside the voter's preferred candidate or party in each of the ballot papers.

- In the North East Region we have no candidates for a Constituency MSP however we have candidates in other constituencies.
- The second ballot paper (peach) is **your opportunity to elect the Christian Party in your Region** and across the whole of Scotland. The Christian Party “Proclaiming Christ’s Lordship” known as the Scottish Christian Party will be on this ballot paper, along with the Scottish Christian Party logo. Put a cross (not numbers 1,2 or3) here. **Remember: Put your cross by the Cross.**

The Scottish Christian Party manifesto, covering every aspect of Governmental responsibility, is available on our website (see details on front page) where it can be studied in detail.

Wasted Votes:

Christians who support the mainstream parties can waste their vote by voting for them in the regional lists. This is due to the way votes are calculated using the number of votes and number of constituency MSPs.
